Administrative History – HALO

UWO HA (Homophile Association) was established in October of 1970 at the University of Western Ontario as a student organization, within a year of the events at Stonewall, New York. At the same time, similar groups were organizing at the Universities of Toronto and Waterloo, among others. At the time of the organization's creation there existed an energetic group of liberators at the University who were able to attract gay and lesbian rights pioneer Dr. F.E. Kemeny in 1971 to give a series of lectures.

The association moved to its current Colborne St. address in 1974 for several reasons one of which was to encourage community involvement. It is unknown whether any documents were lost in the move from UWO campus to the Colborne St. address. Following renovations, which began in 1974, the organisation opened its doors on July 16th of 1975 under the incorporated name of HALO (Homophile Association of London Ontario). Extensive renovations were completed in 1975, and were funded entirely by dances, profits from the bar, and memberships.

Richard Hudler, for whom the Archives are named, became a member of HALO in 1976, and became involved with the Social Services Committee in 1978. The organization was entirely self-financed, and profits were re-directed to provide social services for the gay and lesbian community. Richard Hudler joined the association's voluntary Executive Committee at the end of 1980, as the Chair of Social Services. He became president of HALO in 1981 and remained in this position until 1995. He remains the Chair of Social Services Committee.

After a decade of organising across North America, the gay and lesbian press had become well established, and the gay and lesbian community was becoming aware of the importance of its history. Hudler began collecting documents in 1980 or 1981, with the intention of learning more about the gay and lesbian community history in London for himself. Many of the documents in the archives are financial records and minutes, which were kept for accountants and audits. These documents were put in storage on the building's second floor at the end of each year.

The Pride Library began in James Miller's office (in Middlesex Tower of University College) in September of 1996 when it became obvious that current access to gay and lesbian literature at the University was unsatisfactory. The library was not only a resource centre but it also served as an 'out space' for discussions and watching movies. Book donations began before the library was officially opened, and by February of 1997 the Library contained 130 books. Over the next four months this number grew to 400. The centre also began to function as a social space.

The archives were moved to their current location beside the Pride Library on November 19th, 1997; the Pride Library was formally established as a research centre six days later. Originally, the boxes were kept in the office of James Miller, where they awaited processing. Traçy Paris, a work-study student, began working on a rough

inventory immediately, and then began work on a file inventory. Kym Fortin has since completed this file inventory.

Custodial History

The early documents in the archives originated from UWO HA. They were moved to HALO's current address in 1974. They were moved to the Pride Library on November 19th, 1997. They officially became part of the Library's collection on November 25th, 1997. Unfortunately, certain types of documents were disposed of while housed at the HALO offices, employee time cards for example, so there are gaps in the collection. The documents in the archives all date from 1995 or earlier. The archives are the property of HALO, and are on deposit with the Hudler Archives of the UWO Research Facility for Gay and Lesbian Studies.

Restrictions

The archives is currently closed and will remain closed until further notice.

Series 1: H.A.L.O. CONSTITUTION

Dates of creation: Not Dated
2.0 cm of textual material.

The series consists of four copies of the constitution for the Homophile Association of London, Ontario (HALO) as well as three files of draft material for the constitution.

Series 2: ORGANISATIONAL MINUTES

The series is divided into five sub-series 2.1 Executive Committee & Minutes; 2.2. General Meetings & Minutes; 2.3 Other Committees & Minutes; 2.4 Policy; and 2.5 Staffing.

Sub-series 2.1: Executive Committee & Minutes

Dates of creation: 1973 - 1993
16.0 cm of textual material.

The sub-series consists of typed and hand written copies of minutes from the Executive Committee of the UWO Homophile Association and of HALO.

Sub-series 2.2: General Meetings & Minutes

Dates of creation: 1971 - 1993
22.0 cm of textual material.

The sub-series consists the minutes from the general and annual meetings of the UWO Homophile Association (1971-1974) and from HALO. It also includes motions passed at several general meetings and miscellaneous papers relating to general meetings of HALO.

Sub-series 2.3: Other Committees & Minutes

Dates of creation: 1975, 1979, 1984 - 1986.
7.0 cm of textual material.

The sub-series includes the minutes from various committees within the HALO organisation. Minutes from the following committees are included: Gay Rights Committee (1975); Social Service Committee (1979, 1984); Western Small Business Consulting Program (1985); Council Committee (1984-1986); Ad Hoc Committee to Review the Constitution (1985); Financial Committee (1984, 1986); and the Building Management Committee (1984).

Sub-series 2.4: Policy

Dates of creation: 1974 - 1975, 1979-1984, 1986, 1990.
6.0 cm of textual material.

The series includes the UWO Homophile Association and HALO organisational policies. The Club File from UWO HA from the early 1970's is also included and this contains newsletters and the UWO Club's Handbook.

Sub-series 2.5: Staffing

Dates of creation: 1975, 1979, 1981, 1984 - 1986.
6.0 cm of textual material.

The series contains information related to employees in 1984,1985,1986; employment agreements and release forms; memos to staff; a report on HALO wages and salaries (by Robert Strothard 1981); wages and receipts from 1975; personal appraisal forms from 1985 and 1986; staff job descriptions and evaluation sheets and staff policy and job descriptions.

Sub-series 2.6: Miscellaneous

Dates of creation: Not Dated.
1.0 cm of textual material.

The sub-series consists of records relating to a variety of conferences related to the lesbian and gay community.

Series 3: ENTERTAINMENT & SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

The series is divided into five sub-series 3.1 Committees; 3.2 Membership; 3.3 Coalition for Gay Rights in Ontario (CLGRO); 3.4 Coffee House; and 3.5 Other. This series contains records relating to the social and entertainment components of HALO.

Sub-series 3.1: Committees

Dates of creation: 1979, 1983 - 1986.
10.0 cm of textual material.

The sub-series consists of committee records from HALO's Entertainment Committee, Licensed Disco Committee, Tenth Anniversary Committee, Homecoming Committee, Upper Bar Meetings, and the Nitty Gritty Group.

Sub-series 3.2: Membership

Dates of creation: 1973 - 1976, 1979 - 1982
4.0 cm of textual material.

The sub-series contains records relating to the membership of HALO. Records include mailing lists, the membership roll call, barrments, membership questionnaires, membership cards and applications.

Sub-series 3.3: Coalition for Gay Rights in Ontario (CLGRO)

Dates of creation: 1982 - 1986
3.5 cm of textual material.

The sub-series consists of records relating to CGRO Dance staffing including records from the steering committee, and minutes and memos from the 1982 Conference and the South Western Regional meetings.

Sub-series 3.4: Coffee House

Dates of creation: 1982 - 1985.
3.0 cm of textual material.

The sub-series consists of records relating to the Coffee House run by HALO. Records include committee meeting schedules and minutes, cash counts, and ledgers.

Sub-series 3.5: Miscellaneous

Dates of creation: 1983, 1984, 1987, 1989.
3.5 cm of textual material.

The sub-series contains miscellaneous records relating to the following: Light Show; Music Survey (1989) ; questionnaire 1983; 15th Anniversary; Charity Dance Records; and procedures for the Upstairs Bar.

Series 4: BUILDING RECORDS

This series is divided into four sub-series 4.1 Committees; 4.2 Fund-raising; 4.3 Plans; and 4.4 Non-textual Records. The series contains information relating to the planning, fund-raising and plans for the renovations to the Colborne Street building that HALO occupies.

Sub-series 4.1: Committees

Dates of creation: 1980, 1984, 1985, 1988.
4.0 cm of textual material.

The sub-series contains records relating to building management and location committee work around the Colborne Street building renovations.

Sub-series 4.2: Fund-raising

Dates of creation: 1984 - 1993.

11.0 cm of textual material.

The sub-series consists of records relating to fund-raising activities around the HALO building renovations including listings of foundations, thank you letters, businesses contacted, invitations to the 1987 buying of the building, listings of Service Clubs, letters Re: 1986 Campaign, and support letters.

Sub-series 4.3: Non-textual Ephemera

Dates of creation: 1978, 1979, 1985, 1986.
8.0 cm of non-textual ephemera.

The series includes rough drafts of the building fund brochure; notes on the history of the building; draft copies and proofs of the building fund-raising brochure; and blank building fund thermometers. As well, the sub-series contains six separate blueprint plans for the renovations of HALO's Colborne Street building.

Series 5: CORRESPONDENCE

The series is separated into two sub-series 5.1: Executive Committee and 5.2: General Correspondence.

Sub-series 5.1: Executive Committee

Dates of creation: 1973 - 1980
5.0 cm of textual records

The sub series contains the correspondence of the executive committee members of the UWO Homophile Association and the executive committee members of HALO. The correspondence relates to the organisational operations of HALO as well as correspondence with other lesbian / gay / bisexual organisations.

Sub-series 5.2: General Correspondence

Dates of creation: 1970-1972, 1977-1981, 1983-1986
11.5 cm of textual records

This sub-series includes general correspondence, miscellaneous letters as well as correspondence relating to the creation of the Social Service Directory which was published by HALO. There are also letters concerning the 1985 HALO mailing list. The correspondence deals with matters relating to The correspondence relates to the organisational operations of HALO as well as correspondence with other lesbian / gay / bisexual organisations.

Series 6: FINANCIAL RECORDS

Sub-series 6.1: Financial Papers & Statements

17.0 cm of textual records.

The sub-series contains financial statements, reports, records, and papers, as well as a few inventories.

Sub-series 6.2: Budgets

Dates of creation: 1979, 1983-1985, 1987 [approx.]
3.0 cm of textual records.

This sub-series includes financial budgets, budget projections, and a few financial reports and statements.

Sub-series 6.3: Inventories & Recapitulations

Dates of creation: 1976, 1982-1993.
23.5 cm of textual records.

This sub-series contains inventories, HALO recapitulation sheets, daily and weekly inventory recapitulations, stock ordered and received forms, Disco Deck liquor, beer, popper inventories and receipts, bar inventory monthly recapitulations, consumption reports, differences from inventory value and tape count, a bound and unlabeled blue binder of inventory statements, and some loose inventory papers in a box.

Sub-series 6.4: Cancelled Cheques

Dates of creation: 1974-1975, 1979.
1.5 cm of textual records.

This sub-series contains cancelled cheques (the bulk of which are from 1975), as well as money orders from 1979.

Sub-series 6.5: Receipts

Dates of creation: 1971-1979.
4.0 cm of textual records.

This sub-series contains receipts, copies of receipts issued by HALO, bills, financial records, permits relating to dances, and a ledger book.

Sub-Series 6.6: Ledgers & Reconciliation

Dates of creation: 1975-1984.
9.0 cm of textual records.

This sub-series contains ledgers (one from the building fund), ledger pages, and token reconciliation and reconciliation reports.

Sub-series 6.7: Miscellaneous

Dates of creation: 1975-1976, 1979 & 1980.
2.5 cm of textual records.

This sub-series contains miscellaneous financial records, including float records from the Disco Deck and Coffee House, "Paul Wollaston / Expenses", bank statements, and deposit receipt books.

This sub-series contains permits, as well as receipts from between 1974 & 1976.

Sub-series 7.4: Wills & Insurance

Dates of creation: 1974-1976, 1991-1992.

1.0 cm of textual records.

This sub-series contains wills, insurance records, the HALO Beneficiary, and other similar documents.

Sub-series 7.5: Miscellaneous Legal Documents

This sub-series contains corporate papers, documents relating to the Liquor License Board of Ontario, club licensing, and other legal documents.
